- Student name/contact information
- Academic institution/year in program
- A brief biographical background statement (three paragraphs or less)
- Requested amount and proposed use of travel funds
- Two reference letters from faculty directly involved in the healthcare architecture program

Applications will be reviewed by the Foundation. The selected recipient(s) will be announced at the AIA Academy of Architecture for Health Summer Leadership Summit on July 23, 2016. The selected recipient(s) agrees to prepare a summary report of their travel experiences to the Foundation.
