



Located in the Playa Vista neighborhood of Los Angeles, the clinic is designed to appeal to the diverse demographics of the adjacent tech community of "Silicon Beach" by providing convenient access to high-quality, patient-centered services close to where people live and work. Located on the second, third, and fourth levels of a centrally located building at Runway, an outdoor mall, the clinic is surrounded by restaurants, shops, and a movie theater.


# **Urgent Care**

The Urgent care resides on level 2 as the entrance is flush with the grade level, providing easier access for gurneys and wheelchairs. Inside the clinic entrance, dark wood paneling and linear light fixtures illuminate the way, leading visitors around the corner and into the main lobby for check-in at the reception desk. The lobby, with its warm wood tones and classic neutrals, highlighted with pops of color, offers a variety of comfortable seating options. Beyond the main reception area, an 8,500 SF terrace that extends around to the west side of the building provides a visual distraction and place of respite for patients and staff, as well as serves as an open space for staff gatherings, events, and wellness classes.



## **Design Consideration**

Exam rooms surround the care team area, which serves as a central work zone for the facility's clinical staff, on three sides. To comply with Cedar-Sinai's new organizational standard, the exam rooms on all levels have the same furniture and equipment layout as other new outpatient clinics, but with only one door in and out. The care team space includes workstations for providers shared printers and copiers, a locker area for personal belongings, storage, and a medication supply area. Level 2 also includes x-ray, a triage room, an office, a conference room, a specimen handling room, and a quiet room for staff.


# **Primary Care**

The same material introduced to visitors on level 2 are intertwined into the design of the spaces on the levels above, while taking into consideration the varying patient types. On level 3, a small staircase leads visitors from the glass entryway, featuring graphics inspired by the area's native grasses, into the Primary Care reception area. The waiting area, though smaller than that of the Urgent Care, incorporates the same wood paneling, dark gray marble, white Corian, and back-painted

glass. The Primary Care level includes consult



## **Design Consideration**

These smaller seating spaces, or **living rooms**, provide additional patient privacy away from the main reception. The floor- to- ceiling windows along the southern hallway allow natural light to flow into the spaces, infusing a mix of natural tones, blues, yellow, and oranges, and **incorporates** a beachy, ocean element into the hospitality feel.


# **OB/GYN + Pediatrics**

On level 4, a convenient entry ramp directs visitors from the parking garage through glass entry doors, with graphics reminiscent of the area's prevalent ocean breezes, into the OB/GYN + **Pediatrics clinic**. Similarly designed as the floors below, the reception area is curated with dark wood paneling and gray marble, white Corian, and back-painted glass.





## **Design Consideration**

Two living rooms off the southern corridor mimic the spaces on Level 3, however, incorporate more child-friendly elements, such as a television and playful furniture. The suspended wavy metal grid ceiling makes another appearance, unifying the patient waiting areas, centrallylocated care team spaces, and surrounding patient exam rooms. The OB/GYN + Pediatrics clinic also includes consult rooms, ultrasound, a specimen handling room, a coffee bar/ pantry, a call center, and four small terraces.

## **Design Strategy**

Given the **limited space** in the building, it was decided to move forward with an **on-stage only model**. This ensured an intuitive flow between spaces and met Cedars-Sinai's goals of providing a collaborative team **environment**, while improving their clinical processes. As a result, the clinic was designed with a southern corridor for intimate patient areas, whereas the northern corridor provides a path of travel for the flow of materials, staff, and patients. Both corridors surround an open care team area that serves as a central work zone for the clinical staff, **maximizing** visibility and functionality of clinic operations. Particular attention was paid to efficiencies in the small space, and existing architectural conditions- structural building columns, varying connections between the existing building and the attached garage, and a narrow entry area- were skilfully addressed.




